Electronic Newsletter Distribution:

Welcome to the first edition of our School Newsletter in electronic form. As per the announcement in our last newsletter, only families who have requested a paper copy of the Chatter will receive one from now onwards. As soon as our school Website comes online, our school newsletters will also be available there.

School Development Day:

A reminder to families that this coming Friday (June 3rd) will be a School Development Day, where our staff will be participating in a series of workshops focussing on strategies to improve instruction and curriculum delivery. While all staff will attend on this day, the school will be closed to students. With Monday June 6th being a public holiday to celebrate WA day, please take this time to enjoy an extended long weekend with your children.

Attendance:

An analysis of our 2022 attendance data reveals that we are currently sitting below the state average for student attendance at Carey Park Primary School. This is concerning in that each day missed means that a child is missing out on vital aspects of their education. While we understand that often there is a good reason for a child to be absent from school, it is important on all other occasions that parents/carers send their children to school where possible. The table below demonstrates how cumulative absences can add up over time and have a significant effect upon a child's education:

Average Days absent per Week	Equals over 1 Term (Absences)	Equals over 1 Year (Absences)	Equals over 12 Years of School (Absences)
1	10 Days (2 Weeks)	40 Days or 8 Weeks	96 Weeks or 2.4 Years
2	20 Days (4 Weeks)	80 Days or 16 Weeks or 1.6 Terms	192 Weeks or 4.8 Years
3	30 Days (6 Weeks)	120 Days or 24 Weeks or 2.4 Terms	288 Weeks or 7.2 Years
4	40 Days (8 Weeks)	160 Days or 32 Weeks or 3.2 Terms	384 Weeks or 9.6 Years

Tips to prevent and treat head lice:

- If your child has hair that is longer than shoulder length, it is essential that it is tied up (boys and girls).
- Please check your child's hair regularly to see if there are any signs of live lice or eggs.
- If you discover either live lice or eggs, please do not send your child to school. Rather, keep them home and treat them according to Health Department Instructions.
- Keep your child home until all signs of lice and eggs are gone from your child's hair.
- After treatment, please ensure that all combs, brushes, clothing and bed linen is thoroughly washed to eradicate any remaining eggs or lice.

2023 Kindergarten:

Carey Park Primary School are now taking 2023 Kindy enrolments for children born between **1 July 2018** and **30 June 2019**. Enrolment packages can be picked up from Administration. If you know of someone who may have a 2023 kindy-aged child, please let them know that places are open. Alternatively, call the school on 9796 2900 for enquiries.

Canteen Lunches:

In the past the school has provided lunches to children who have come to school with none. While this practice will continue on Mondays & Tuesdays, for the remainder of the week we have an affordable option of a basic sandwich for \$1.00 that is available from the canteen. Children without lunch on these days will be sent to the canteen to get a sandwich, with families being notified this has occurred.

- Fear – will my child end up in prison?
