#### Arrivals/Departures

It is Department of Education policy that Pre-primary children be escorted to the teacher at the commencement of the session and collected from the teacher at the end of the session by an approved **adult**. We are not permitted to allow Pre-primary children to walk to or from Pre-primary by themselves.

If you wish an adult who is not on your contact list to collect your child, please notify us in writing. As we have a duty of care for your children, there can be no exceptions to this. If your child needs collecting earlier, please obtain a "Student Release" card from the office prior to collection.

Young children become distressed if they are left waiting for parents and especially if they are consistently the last to be collected. If for any reason you are going to be late, please let us know so that we can let your child know.

## **Emergency Numbers**

It is important that you provide at least two emergency contact numbers for your child so that if anything does happen we can contact someone.

Please keep these numbers up to date and let the office know of all new details.

#### **Communications**

The school will send newsletters home (one per family) each fortnight. In addition, please download the **PBIS Rewards Family** App, which will allow the school to keep you up to date with current events.


## **Birthdays**

#### School Canteen

The P & C operates a canteen on Wednesday, Thursday and Fridays only. Pre-primary children are able to order lunches on this day.

#### **School Uniform**

A Uniform Shop is located on site and run by the P & C. Opening times will be on Wednesdays and Fridays, 8.15am – 8.45am. If you are unable to get to the uniform shop and require uniforms, please see administration. New and second-hand uniforms can be purchased, although stock is limited on second hand uniforms.

#### Attendance

As Pre-primary is the first year of compulsory schooling, parents/carers are expected to inform the school on the first day of any absence by giving a reason for the absence and a likely date of return. Please inform the school by one of the following options (only one of the options is required):

# **Ambulance Policy**

The school will always attempt to contact the parents. If the school judges that professional care is **urgently** required, the school will call for an ambulance immediately. Parents should assume that the school will put the needs of the child first and always seek professional assistance if this appears warranted. Parents will be responsible for paying the cost of the ambulance call-out. Any parent who is uneasy about the above policy must provide the school with written advice about how they want the school to respond in the event of a serious injury to their child.

#### Medication

If your child requires medication whilst at Pre-primary, the medication instruction forms regarding dosage, times and any other relevant information must be completed. These forms are available from the school office.

#### Infectious Diseases Exclusion Information

There are certain diseases that the Education Department requires we be notified of. If your child has any of these illnesses, please notify the staff immediately. Current Health Department policy requires schools to temporarily exclude children who have not been immunised against measles in the case of an outbreak. More information is available from the school office.

#### **Medical Checks**

Pre Primary students will have a dental check provided by the School Dental Therapy Unit. Health and dental forms will be issued for completion in term one. Please return promptly.

Once your child has had their four year old immunisations, can you please bring an Immunisation History Statement from ACIR (Australian Childhood Immunisation Register) into the school office to copy for our records. You can get a copy of your child's immunisation history statement from:

#### **Pre-primary Program**

The Pre-primary Program provides a wide variety of experiences for the children.

Indoors the children explore areas such as:

- Literacy
- Numeracy
- Painting
- Block building
- Playdough
- Matching and sorting

- Cooking
- Home Corner dramatic play
- Music movement
- Designing creating
- Listening and speaking

The children also participate in group activities during mat times, fruit time and story time etc.

Outdoors, the children engage in activities such as:

- running
- climbing
- digging
- jumping
- swinging
- throwing
- catching

The children will gain control over large and small muscles, co-operation with others, an understanding about the world around them, use their imagination and creative ability and respect the rights of others. Children learn through play by doing.

## Parent Help Roster

We value parent help and encourage mums and dad's participation in our program. A parent help roster will be displayed early in Term One to give parents the opportunity to meet staff and to see their child interacting within their group. Try to make time to spend at least two half-day sessions with us each term. Your child will enjoy you sharing his/her experiences. When on roster parent duties include:

- Talking to the children
- Helping to prepare materials
- Guiding children with activities
- Cleaning up
- · Watching your child and playing with him/her
- Reading books

Relatives and caregivers are also welcome to attend on roster. If you, your friends or relatives have any skills or hobbies they would like to share with the children please let us know and we can include them in our program. Your help is vital to our program.



#### Laundry Roster

Each Friday one child will be given a bag of washing, hand towels, tea towels, aprons etc. Please wash and return this on the following Monday. Your assistance with this roster is greatly appreciated.
